Outstanding BS Degree Graduate

The Outstanding BS Degree is awarded to a student who receives their BS degree during current academic year, has an excellent GPA, attitude, and dedication to coursework.

WDD Scholarship

The Wlasuk, Delporte & Davis Scholarship is awarded to the Outstanding CpET student. The student must have a soph/jr standing, financial needed, and recommendation from an ECET faculty member.

ECET Merit Scholarship

The ECET Merit Scholarship is presented to an Outstanding ECET student. The student must have financial need and recommendation from an ECET faculty member.

John Ryan Memorial Scholarship

The John Ryan Memorial Scholarship is presented to an outstanding BMET student. The student must have completed ECET 107 and 109, and demonstrate financial need.

William Seibert Memorial Scholarship

The William Seibert Memorial Scholarship is presented to an outstanding ECET student. The student must have completed ECET 107 and 109, demonstrate financial need and service to the department.

Thomas Willison Memorial Scholarship

The Thomas Willison Memorial Scholarship is presented to an outstanding ECET student. The student must have financial need and recommendation from an ECET faculty member.

Frank Burley Memorial Scholarship

The Frank Burley Memorial Scholarship is presented to an ECET student who has a 3.2 or higher GPA. The student must have completed ECET 107, 109, 157, and 207.

Electronics Manufacturing Scholarship

Preference is given to an employee of EMS. Student is selected based on their interest in the field of electronics manufacturing, academic merit, and financial need.
