## DESCRIPTION OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

---

---

The B.S. in Organizational Leadership and Supervision (OLS) requires a total of **124** credit hours, with the guiding vision of closing the gap between theory and practice. The program design provides each student with a balanced foundation: approximately **1/3** Leadership; **1/3** Technology, Math, and Science; and **1/3** Communication and General Education. A flexible curriculum permits students to pursue the Human Resource Certificate with the additional **15** credit hours of OLS electives and general electives and/or fill the Applied Technology requirement with a technical certificate, or a minor. A cumulative GPA of 2.0 (C) or higher is required for graduation.

---

### Major Core Requirements and Prerequisites – 43 credit hours

Of the 43 hours required in OLS, twenty-eight (28) must include OLS 100, **252**, 263, 274, **327**, 331, **371**, **390**, **410**, and **490**. Beyond the required courses, 15 additional credit hours of OLS encourage personalization in leadership and supervision competency to match career interests. **Note: A grade of C (2.0) or higher is required in all Major Core OLS coursework.**

- ENG W131 or equivalent, COMM R110, OLS 100, or the consent of the OLS department are co/ prerequisites for OLS 252, 263, and 274.
- OLS 274 is the prerequisite for IET 350.
- ENG W131 or equivalent, COMM R110, OLS 252, and junior standing are prerequisites for OLS 327.
- OLS 327, 371, and TCM 320 are co/prerequisites for OLS 390.
- Senior standing, completion of all Math and Communications requirements, 33 hours of OLS coursework, and OLS 390, prerequisites for OLS 410 and 490. **Note: OLS 410 and 490 cannot be taken concurrently.**

### Technical Core Requirements – 39 credit hours

Choose up to **24** credit hours in applied technology competency that complements OLS and directly relates to a specific career interest; **18** credit hours must be in a single department such as CNT, CPT, EET, MET, Business School, Nursing, Allied Health, Informatics, or SPEA. These courses must be related to a minor, a certificate, or reflect some logical combination of approved coursework. Students will be directed to the appropriate counselor for a certificate or minor; and the faculty in that department will counsel the student for those required courses. The balance of the technical core consists of **15** credits hours from science and mathematics.

**Note: Students must have the set of courses they plan to apply to the related technology area pre-approved by an OLS academic counselor.**

- **6** credit hours in mathematical applications, which must include IET 350 and an introductory course in statistics. The introductory course in statistics must be selected after consultation with an OLS advisor. Statistic requirement may be met by taking IET150, ECON E270, CPT 120, or STAT 301.
- **6** credit hours in mathematical skills including MATH 153 & 154 or MATH M118 & M119 or equivalent. If Math 159 or an equivalent or higher-level 5-credit hour course is substituted then one additional credit hour approved by an OLS advisor must be earned.
- **3** credit hours in an approved science elective.

### General Education Core Requirements – 42 credit hours

- Complete **24** credit hours in communication including COMM R110, ENG W131, TCM 220, TCM 320, and OLS 474. The **9** credit hour balance must be composed of department approved communication and/or writing coursework.
- Complete **18** credit hours of general education electives. **3** credit hours must come from Humanities and **3** credit hours must come from a Behavioral or Social Science to "round out" the B.S. degree and expose students to different disciplines and perspectives. Prior approval by an OLS advisor is **strongly** recommended.
