DESCRIPTION OF ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The Associate of Science Degree in Organizational Leadership and Supervision (OLS) requires a total of 61 credit hours. Twenty-two (22) credit hours are required in OLS. The balance of the requirements for graduation is as follows:

-
- ENG W131 or equivalent is the prerequisite for OLS 263
 - OLS 252, 274, W131, COMM R110, or the consent of the OLS department are prerequisites for OLS 327.
 - OLS 100, 252, 263, 274, 327, 378, W131, TCM 220, and COMM R110 are pre/corequisites for OLS 390.
-
- Choose up to 18 credit hours in an applied technology that complements OLS and directly relates to specific career interests. At least 3 credit hours must demonstrate computer competency. 12 credit hours must be in a single department such as CNT, CPT, EET, MET, Business School, Nursing, Allied Health, etc. These courses must be related to a second degree, a minor, a certificate, or reflect some logical combination of courses. **Note: Students must have the set of courses they plan to apply to the related technology area pre-approved by an OLS academic counselor.**
-
- 3 credit hours in behavioral or social sciences, selected from courses in anthropology, psychology, sociology, economics, and/or geography (see OLS counselor for approved geography courses with a social science dimension).
-
- 9 credit hours in communications ENG W131, COMM R110, and TCM 220
-
- 6 credit hours in mathematical skills including MATH 153 & 154 or MATH 118 & 119 or equivalent. If Math 151 or an equivalent or higher-level 5-hour course is substituted then one additional credit hour approved by an OLS advisor must be earned.
 - 3 credit hours in statistics such as IET 150, STAT 301 etc.
